Stump 'n Stomp – Political candidates and public officials "go grape" with one minute of stumping and two minutes of stompin' for a \$100 per team donation!

Business Bunch Challenge – Local businesses "show me the grapes" going foot to foot with the competition for a \$100 team donation!

Oktoberfest Open – Everyone else is invited to test their tootsies in the barrels and show the rest of the classes what "getting graped" is all about for a \$30 per team donation!

The team in each class stompin' out the most juice wins!

Note: Each team consists of 3 team members – two stompers -- stomping 1 ½ minutes each -- and one swabber to keep the drain cleared and allow juice to drain.
